### Change Notes

With the goal of improving the user experience the Esri France 2023 Dataset was completely reorganized to be sorted and organized by vintage and by grouping population, housing and business data together. The number of data collections was increased to make it easier to find variables in the data browser experience. The births variable for all years were included in a single historical birth table instead of separate tables for each year. Almost all the variable IDs were changed to remove the references to vintage so that future releases of this data will be much easier for developers and users to update the applications, reports and infographics referencing this dataset. Due to the significant reorganization and almost complete replacement of variable IDs with this data update we are providing a crosswalk of old variable ID to new variable ID.

Dataset is based on statistics provided by the French National Institute of Statistics and Economic Studies (INSEE).
