Change Notes

Market Data are now projections for 2022 (before: 2020). Unemployed persons are shown for 2021 (before 2019). Consumer Spending in 2022 shows variations compared to 2020 with shifts within categories due to the lifting of restrictions under the Covid 19 pandemic. Using new input data from the Census 2021 leads to deviations in the variables. Due to a new structure within the official source data, Education can not be compared to the previous version.

The settlement points have been updated with newer INEGI data. These settlement points are an improvement over the previous version and could result in changes to previously run values in some trade areas. Settlement points are used in the data apportionment algorithm to redistribute data variables to input polygon features.

Other Data Notes

Households by Type are based on the per-household-values of the respective Municipios. For reason of data privacy for areas with less than 10 inhabitants all given data except population and household numbers are anonymized. For these areas, all variables
