Change Notes

Market Data are now projections for 2023 (before: 2022). Unemployed Persons are shown for 2022 (before 2021). The Purchasing Power projections for 2023 show an upward trend due to high inflation and an upward revision of the 2022 Purchasing Power. Consumer Spending 2023 shows high deviations from last year's delivery due to high inflation in almost all European countries and significant volatility of the raw data of the official statistical offices in the aftermath of Covid-19 pandemic. Using new input data from the Census 2021 leads to deviations in Population and the respective dependent variables. Based on official statistics, the number of Unemployed Persons shows a significant decline due to an economic recovery after the Covid-19 pandemic. The new Census 2021 data showed an 11% decline of population compared to former estimates and was included in the new projection for 2023.

No changes were made to these settlement points since the last MBR release.

Other Data Notes

Households and Household Types are based on per household values of respective Opstini. Age, Gender, Education, Marital Status, Unemployed Persons, Purchasing Power and Consumer Spending are based on per capita values of respective Opstini.
