## 7) Routing/Network Dataset Changes:

a. Added 'TruckMinutes' impedance/cost attribute. The calculation logic of the 'TruckTravelTime' impedance has been moved to the 'TruckMinutes' impedance.

With this 2018 SMP release and using ArcGIS 10.6 or later, when a start time is specified, the new calculation logic of the 'TruckTravelTime' impedance uses a combination of historic traffic information and jurisdictional truck speed limits to give more realistic travel times. If a start time is not specified, the 'TruckTravelTime' impedance will fall back to the 'TruckMinutes' impedance logic.

With previous 2017 SMP releases and/or using ArcGIS 10.5.1 or earlier, when a start time is specified, the 'TruckTravelTime' uses the historic traffic information for automobiles, which is less realistic. In this case it is recommended to use the 'TruckMinutes' impedance instead. If a start time is not specified, the 'TruckTravelTime' impedance will fall back to the 'TruckMinutes' impedance logic.

 Added 'Vehicle Maximum Speed (km/h)' parameter to 'TravelTime' and 'TruckTravelTime' cost attributes that allows for manually setting a maximum speed limit for vehicles.

## 8) Deprecations:

The StreetMap Premium for ArcGIS North America TomTom product will be deprecated after this 2018 Release 1 version. No more versions of the product will be produced after the 2018 release. Users of the StreetMap Premium for ArcGIS North America TomTom product will be supported until their license expires. Users will have the option to switch to a comparable product upon renewal of their license.
